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

COVER MEMO

Summary Memo — October 20, 2022

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Note on methods:

Between August 11, 2022 and September 13, 2022, we surveyed 26,616 individuals across all 50 states plus the District of Columbia. The survey was conducted by PureSpectrum via an online, nonprobability sample, with state-level representative quotas for race/ethnicity, age, and gender (for methodological details on the other waves, see [covidstates.org](https://www.covidstates.org)). In addition to balancing on these dimensions, we reweighted our data using demographic characteristics to match the U.S. population with respect to 2020 vote choice and turnout, race/ethnicity, age, gender, education, and living in urban, suburban, or rural areas. This was the latest in a series of surveys we have been conducting since April 2020, examining attitudes and behaviors regarding COVID-19 in the United States.

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The Mar-A-Lago Search


This report contains some key takeaways, a brief write-up, some summary statistics, and a collection of open-ended responses surrounding public opinion of the August 8, 2022 FBI search of Donald Trump's estate, Mar-A-Lago.

Key takeaways

- A large majority of Americans quickly became aware of the Mar-A-Lago search. Overall, 81 percent reported that they were aware of the search. Additionally, 82 percent of those who took the survey within a week after the search were already aware of it.
- Overall, Americans approved of the search by a 51-27 margin. Another 22 percent neither supported nor opposed the search.
- Democrats overwhelmingly supported the FBI search of Mar-A-Lago by an 84-3 margin. Over two thirds (69 percent) of Democrats strongly supported the search.
- A strong majority of Republicans opposed the search by a 64-13 margin. Additionally, 47 percent of Republicans strongly opposed the search.
- Independents were nearly twice as likely to support the search as they were to oppose it, with a 47-24 margin. Close to a third (32 percent) of independents strongly supported the search.
- The intensity of Republican opposition to the search decreased slightly as time following the search increased. While Republican support for the raid remained very low in both cases, those strongly opposing the raid dropped from 54 percent of Republicans who responded within a week of the search to 46 percent of Republicans who responded at least one week after the search. Very few Republicans supported the search regardless of when they took the survey, but the percentage of those *strongly* opposing it dipped over time.

The most recent wave of our survey unsurprisingly revealed a drastic partisan gap in support for the FBI search of Mar-A-Lago. While the public generally supported the search by a 51-27 margin, Democrats (84-3 support) were significantly more supportive of the search than Republicans (64-13 oppose). Independents supported the search by a 47-24 margin. Partisanship, ideology, and Trump thermometer score were all strong predictors of attitudes towards the search. For example, a one degree increase in Trump’s thermometer score was associated with nearly a one percent decrease in probability of support for the search.

Data collection for this wave began on August 11, three days after the search, so we are not able to capture the most immediate reactions to the search. We can nevertheless break down attitudes by proximity to the search to look for any temporal differences.

Here, we found that Republican support for the raid was very low regardless of when the survey was taken, but the intensity of Republican opposition to the search did decrease as time following the search passed. Fifty-four percent of Republicans who took the survey within one week of the search (August 11-August 15) strongly opposed the search, which dropped to 46 percent among those who responded at least one week after the search.

Among Republicans, support for the search remained between 11 and 13 percent regardless of which period respondents took the survey in, suggesting that even though the initial intense opposition to the search declined over time, few Republicans fully switched their view and supported the search. Democrats steadfastly supported the search regardless of when they took the survey.



The open-ended responses lend support to the notion that respondents based their opinion on the search on how they felt about Trump. Among pro-search respondents, we observed five overlapping themes motivating their support for the search: general disdain of Trump, the belief that nobody is above the law, trust in the FBI, Trump having nothing to worry about if he did not do anything wrong, and the argument that some sort of action from the FBI or Department of Justice was long overdue and should have happened sooner.

Anti-search Republicans regularly repeated five rival themes: that the search was an abuse of power, that it was “political” and a “witch hunt,” that prominent Democratic leaders should be investigated instead, that it was an invasion of Donald and Melania Trump’s privacy, and that it was a Democratic attempt to distract the public from Biden’s policy failures. Examples of quotes from respondents falling under each of these themes are below.¹

Appendix B: Open-ended Responses

Overall, 35% of respondents left an open-ended comment. Our team sifted through 9,334 open-ended responses and identified five major themes on both sides:
