2. Social Media Affects Lack of Interest in Reading the Qur'an Among Teens

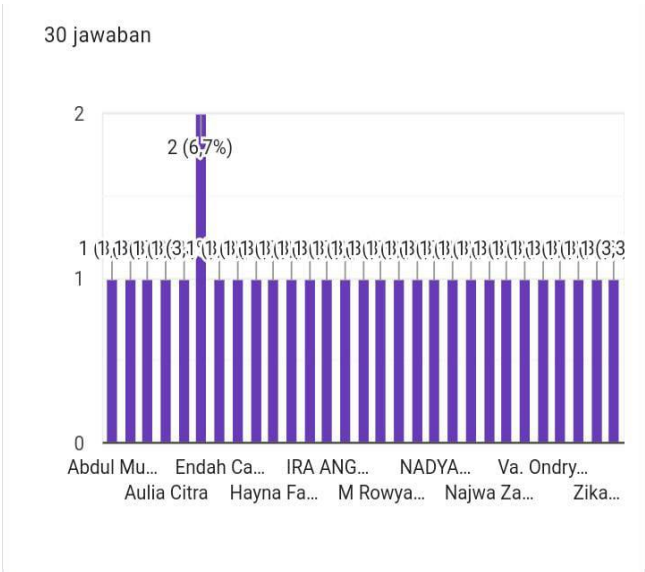
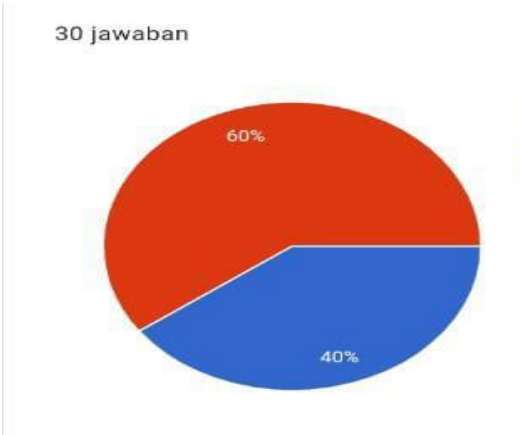
